The instruction plan below will be subject to regular review in consultation with students, and modified or updated as necessary, as further information becomes available.

The class will meet virtually (webex meetings) during the regularly-scheduled times (T,R,F, 1:00-2:30). Students can join the meetings at:

Instruction will be provided via audio, with written notes transcribed on a tablet using screen-sharing with all participants. Student will be encouraged to use the messaging feature of webex to ask questions during lectures, or they can use their audio connections (students should mute their microphones when not asking a question to avoid feedback issues). It is planned to upload lecture content to canvas for future access.

Homework assignments will continue to be posted to canvas as before, but now students are required to upload their solutions as electronic files for grading. Following consultation with the textbook publisher, Wiley, there may be a transition to using Wiley's online homework feature, which can be made freely available to students.

Exams will be conducted using online proctoring. Due to the recent cancellation of classes on March 12 & 13, Exam 2 has been postponed until Tuesday, March 24th at 1:00pm. Students will be provided with detailed instructions for exams via the canvas page for the course.

Office hours will also be conducted using webex.
